New COVID-19 Vaccines for young children
(6 months through 5 years of age):

- Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine in individuals 6 months through 4 years of age (3-dose primary series)
- Moderna COVID-19 vaccine in individuals 6 months through 5 years of age (2-dose primary series)

WOCHD COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics (subject to change due to supply and demand) carry all Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson/Janssen COVID-19 vaccines, including vaccinations for primary a  series.

Walk-ins

No appointments necessary.

No insurance is needed. **Bring your COVID-19 Vaccination Card, a driver's license, photo ID or other proof of address.** No residency restrictions. Patients under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Homebound COVID-19 Vaccination Program

Individuals who are homebound can call WOCHD to schedule a home COVID-19 vaccination visit. Ohio County residents can call (304) 234-3682 to set up an appointment and vaccination type.
